
## Inter•Poll Network Administrator's Utility





## **Overview**

The Inter • Poll "Network Administrator's Utility contains tools an Apple Talk network administrator can use to implement a network support program. These tools cover network mapping, trouble-shooting methods, selective searches for active devices, network-link integrity tests, and version reporting for workstation system software. Together, these tools help the Apple Talk network administrator eliminate many network problems before they adversely affect users.
