



High Performance Access Router Manager (HiPer™ ARM) Quick Reference Card for Unix

Read on for quick tips on using HiPer ARC's graphical user interface (GUI).

HiPer ARM Lets You...

- Set HiPer ARC user parameters.
- Configure the IP or IPX network for HiPer ARC.
- Identify hosts and servers.
- Set RADIUS security and authentication.
- Upgrade HiPer ARC software.

To Install HiPer ARM...

- HiPer ARM is installed as a part of the Transcend installation, via the TCM option.
- When you follow the onscreen instructions to install Transcend, make sure that you click the TCM Install option. The TCM installation includes HiPer ARM software.

Start HiPer ARM...

- Via a currently running network management application like HP[®] Open View Network Node Manager or SUN[®] Net Manager, or
- Launch from the TCM Menu bar item, TCM HiPer Access Router Manager.

To Start HiPer ARM Online Help...

Click Help on the Menu bar.

Toolbar Highlights...

Toolbar buttons are shown next. Just click to start these functions.

IMPORTANT: You must always click **Set** after changing a parameter.
