Welcome!

HP-UX 11i Instant Information provides the latest editions of HP-UX user and application documentation for your HP-UX 10.20, 11.00 and 11i system. The Instant Information browser, called DynaText, can be installed and run on the currently supported versions of HP-UX or Microsoft Windows listed below.

System Requirements

- **Systems:** HP-UX 10.20, 11.00, 11i or later (CD files can be viewed with earlier systems).
Microsoft Windows 3.1, WFW 3.11, Win95/98/2000 or NT.
- **PC Memory:** Windows: 8MB, min. 16 MB recommended.
- **Disk Space:** HP-UX: 80 MB (install), 40 MB (final).
Windows: 16 MB (plus 6MB if adding Japanese files).
- **PC Monitor:** VGA min. SVGA recommended.

Windows95, Windows98, Windows2000, NT, MS-DOS and Microsoft are U.S. registered trademarks of Microsoft Corporation.

Installing on HP-UX

1. Insert the HP Instant Information CD into the CD-ROM drive and wait for the CD drive's busy light to stop blinking.
2. A typical CD-ROM device name (listed in the Description field) is: `/dev/dsk/c1t2d0`
3. Create the directory `/cdrom` under root(`/`):

```
mkdir /cdrom
```

4. Still as root, mount the CD onto the `/cdrom` directory as a file system:

```
mount -o cdcase /dev/dsk/c1t2d0 /cdrom  
(The -o cdcase option is needed to handle lowercase.)
```

5. Set up the source depot for installation:

```
/cdrom/uxinstal/setup.sh /cdrom
```

6. Run swinstall to install Instant Information software:

```
/usr/sbin/swinstall -s  
/var/spool/sw/InstInfo
```

7. In the Software Selection window, select (highlight) the **InstantInformaxn** product, then select **Actions -> Mark for Install**. The Marked ? column will be set to Yes.
8. Select **Actions -> Install (analysis...)**. When the analysis is finished with no errors (Status:Ready), click **OK**.
9. In the Confirmation window, click **Yes** to begin the installation. After the installation completes successfully, exit swinstall.
10. Add this path in your .profile PATH statement:
`/opt/dynatext/bin`

To re-initialize your .profile, enter:

```
. .profile
```

11. To run the Dynatext browser, enter:

dynatext

Note: Unless you install book files on a hard disk, the Instant Information CD must be mounted to access books. For help placing books on a hard drive, see the readme file: `/cdrom/uxinstal/readme`
For other administration tasks, see the *DynaText Administration on HP-UX* book in the "HP Instant Information Administration" collection.

Updating Book Files

If Dynatext 3.1.1 is already installed on your HP-UX system, follow these steps to update the browser to find books on this new Instant Information CD:

Mount the new CD to the `/cdrom` directory (steps 1-3 above).

Update Dynatext's book list:

```
/cdrom/uxinstal/newdisk.sh /cdrom /opt/dynatext
```

If you put books on a local hard drive, the second */cdrom* path above should point to that location rather than the */cdrom* mount point.

Installing on PCs

1. With MS Windows or Windows NT running, insert the Instant Information CD into the local CD-ROM drive.
2. Run the setup program:
To install the entire Instant Information product, enter:

D:\pcinstal\setup.exe

If Instant Information is already on your PC, use the */locate* option to add new book files. Assuming your CD-ROM drive is at D, enter:

D:\pcinstal\setup.exe /locate

Follow the displayed instructions to complete the installation. In the last screen, select **Run Instant Informa-**

tion and click **Finish**.

For help using Instant Information, click Dynatext's ? box.

3. To place a shortcut to Instant Information on your Windows98/2000 or NT 4.0 desktop window:
 - a. Select: **Start -> Windows Explorer**
 - b. Select: **C: Program Files -> HP -> Instant Information -> Bin**
 - c. Right-click over the **Dtext** file and select **Create Shortcut**.
 - d. Drag the shortcut to your desktop window.
